### Background:

The purpose of this project is to take a fresh look at the congestion, operations and safety need on US199 and Redwood Avenue in west Grants Pass, examining all modes. The planning boundary is generally between Dowell Road to the west, Tussey Lane to the east, US199 to the south and Redwood Avenue to the north. The project will also consider a future fourth bridge connection between Lincoln Avenue and Allen Creek Road as shown in the city's Transportation System Plan.

ODOT proposes to fund this project utilizing \$300,000 from Region 3 savings and \$100,000 from the City of Grants Pass.

# **Options:**

With approval, ODOT will add the project to the STIP as outlined above.

Without approval, this project would not be added to the STIP at this time, and the safety of the corridor would not be explored until a later date.
